Gypsy Way Area: This area is associated with prehistoric/historic trail that runs through the figure eight of the Fair. There has been a lot of prehistoric remains found in the past in this area. Isolated arrowheads, flakes, and large areas of fire cracked rock and charcoal (suggesting the likelihood of camas ovens in the area). As you can see by the map the possibility of more archaeological material within the proposed expansion area is highly likely. "High land" in the area will have prehistoric features the "low lands" will have vernal pond features.
